Library Director's Report February 2023

The trend we are seeing with increased use of the library by patrons continues through February aided by mild weather and Saturday Family programs. We had a 38% increase in visitors over last February along with a dramatic increase in study room reservations—385 in February of 2022 vs. 675 this February—and we are seeing many more questions at the Reference Desks.

Fun and interactive Black History Month programs were highly successful all ages programs. We borrowed a wind tube from the DuPage Children's Museum for a STEM program inspired by NASA's first African American female engineer Mary Williams, and hosted a craft station related to the popular Black Panther superhero movies and West African history. Adding programs in real time when we see attendance fill up has allowed more patrons to participate, for example we added a second GLOW Party after the original Friday night program filled to capacity.
